1. Name of the Fair

5. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. These Regulations define the conditions for the use of the Organizer's services by Visitors during the Fair.
2. Admission to the Fair area means acceptance of these Regulations and the Regulations of the EXPO XXI facility by Visitors who undertake to comply with them.
3. Entrance to the Fair is possible after purchasing a ticket at the Ticket Office on the premises of the EXPO XXI facility or after prior registration, which can be done online at www.zielentozycie.pl or at the Visitor Service Center during the Fair.
4. Visitors registering online and at the Fair itself bear full responsibility for the accuracy of the data provided by them, including the consequences of incomplete or incorrect data, in particular the email address.

5. Lectures, workshops, lectures, trainings, etc. may be held as part of the Fair - participation in some accompanying events may require prior registration on the website of the Fair or its Partners.
6. Journalistic accreditations can be made via the website www.zielentozycie.pl. The Organizer has the right to decide on the granting of accreditation. A decision to grant or reject accreditation is final and not subject to appeal.
7. Entry to the Fair is possible on the basis of a ticket, invitation or printed confirmation of registration with a code, or presented on an electronic device, e.g. smartphone or tablet.
8. At the same time all persons participating in the Fair agree to the use of their image for promotional purposes of the event (e.g. for photo or film documentation).
9. Visitors to the Fair and who leave their data during registration agree to receive marketing and commercial information by email, post and telephone from the Organizer, other Exhibitors and Partners of the Fair.
10. Any advertising or commercial activity is prohibited on the Fair without prior agreement with the Organizer.
11. All Visitors are required to have an admission ticket, or an invitation or confirmation of registration. The Organizer reserves the right to refuse entry to the Fair area to persons who do not have any of the above.

REGULATIONS FOR CONDUCT

1. Visitors may stay on the premises of the Fair only during its opening hours.
2. It is forbidden for Visitors to carry out any commercial, acquisition, advertising, promotional and fundraising activities, as well as activities that are inconsistent with applicable law.
3. If photographing, filming and making drawings of individual stands and exhibits cause disturbances in the organization and holding of the Fair or accompanying events, the Organizer may issue an order to suspend/stop them. Persons who do not comply with this point may be removed from the Fair area at the Organizer's request.
4. It is forbidden to:
 - a) bring in and consume alcohol, with the exception of consuming alcoholic beverages purchased or served in places designated by the Fair Organizer;
 - b) distribute or consume drugs;
 - c) disturb public order (e.g. loud, aggressive behavior);
 - d) bring in animals or equipment such as bicycles, skateboards, etc.;
 - e) damage the infrastructure, e.g. lean on elements of stand construction, advertising structures or other elements of spatial arrangement.
5. In the event of non-compliance with the prohibitions listed in point. 4. The Organizer reserves the right to immediately remove the Visitor from the event venue and prevent him or her from re-entering, and in justified cases, to call the Police.
6. The Organizer is not liable for damage to the property of the Visitors caused by force majeure (e.g. fire, explosion, lightning strike, storms, flooding) or by third parties or caused by fault of the Visitor.
7. Visitors are required to:
 - a) respect the markings of zones separating traffic subject to fire protection;
 - b) carry out cleaning orders issued by security services for organizational reasons or the need to protect property and ensure the safety of people staying on the premises of the Fair;
 - c) remove self-generated waste and throw it into containers intended for this purpose;
 - d) children under the age of 13 may stay on the Fairgrounds only under the care of adults (parents, guardians).

FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel or change the date of the Fair for reasons beyond the Organizer's control, providing information about this on the Organizer's website.
2. The Regulations are available at www.zielentozycie.pl.
3. In matters not covered by the Regulations, provisions of the Civil Code shall apply. Any disputes will be considered by the competent court.
4. The Polish Nurserymen Association and the Agencja Promocji Zieleni have the exclusive right to interpret these regulations.
